Office Memorandum

**Subject:** Representations submitted by M/s. The Dharamsi Morarji Chemicals AS. Ltd. (DMCC) and M/s The Phosphate Company Limited, Kolkata for considering 1.10.2009 as the effective date for recognizing production Bench Mark for production of SSP during three months period at Khemli unit of DMCC under the revised policy dated 13.8.2009 for Single Super Phosphate (SSP) Fertilizer applicable with effect from 1.10.2009.

The undersigned is directed to say that Department of Fertilizers granted marketing arrangement to M/s. DMCC, Khemli unit, for the sale of its SSP through M/s. The Phosphate Company Limited, during 2009-10 from 1.10.2009 to 31.3.2010 vide letter No. 17011/3/2009-MPR dated 16.10.2009 under the guidelines dated 13.8.2009.

2. The above said scheme, inter alia, provides that ad hoc concession for SSP w.e.f 1<sup>ST</sup> October 2009 would be provided to those eligible SSP units only, which have either annual capacity utilization of at least 50% or annual production of 40,000 MT of SSP, which ever is lower. For the purpose of recognizing capacity utilization/ production, capacity as on 31<sup>ST</sup> March 2009 would be taken into account. The capacity utilization/ production of the unit for three months from the date of the notification dated 13.8.2009 on pro-rata basis would be taken into account for benchmark for ad hoc subsidy for sales of SSP w.e.f 1<sup>ST</sup> October 2009. Further, effective date for reckoning the production benchmark could be considered by Department of Fertilizers as per the request from SSP units on case-to-case basis.

3. M/s. DMCC and M/s. The Phosphate Company Limited, made representations dated 18.12.2009 and 21.12.2009 respectively with the request to consider 1.10.2009 to 31.12.2009 as the effective date/period for recognizing production Benchmark for SSP produced at Khemli Unit during three months period above, instead of 13.8.2009.

4. The matter has been examined in the Department and accordingly the request of the above said companies has been acceded to. PDIL shall monitor the production of the units in its six monthly reports.
