
Subject: Revised policy for ad hoc concession for Single Super Phosphate (SSP) fertilizers with effect from 1.10.2009 under the guidelines dated 13.8.2009.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the above said scheme, inter alia, provides that ad hoc concession for SSP w.e.f 1ST October 2009 would be provided to those eligible SSP units only, which have either annual capacity utilization of at least 50% or annual production of 40,000 MTs of SSP, whichever is lower. For the purpose of recognizing capacity utilization/ production, capacity as on 31st March 2009, would be taken into account. The capacity utilization/ production of the unit for three months from the date of the notification dated 13.8.2009 on pro-rata basis would be taken into account for benchmark for ad hoc subsidy for sales of SSP w.e.f 1st October 2009. Further, effective date for reckoning the production benchmark could be considered by Department of Fertilizers as per the request from SSP units on case-to-case basis.

2. In the above backdrop, the SSP units are required to submit a certificate certifying their eligibility for claiming payment of concession under the guidelines dated 13.8.2009 with effect from 1.10.2009, as per annexed proforma, duly signed by the authorized signatory as well as the Statutory Auditor of the company. This certificate is required to be submitted by the units only in the beginning before claiming payment of concession under the above said scheme.
