Subject: Base Rates for payment of Concession for decontrolled Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) Fertilizers for the year 2008-09 – indigenous and imported Triple Super Phosphate (TSP: 0-46-0).

Madam/ Sir,


I am directed to convey the decision of the Government to include indigenous and imported TSP under the Concession Scheme for decontrolled Phosphatic and Potassic Fertilizers with Maximum Retail Price (MRP) of Rs. 7460 per MT and Base Rate of Concession at Rs. 31508 per MT w.e.f 1st April 2008.

2. All the manufacturers/ importers covered under the concession scheme will be eligible for payment of concession on TSP as per the base rate indicated above.
3. In case, monthly final rate of concession announced by the Government of India subsequently in any month during the year 2008-09 falls below the base rate, such final lower rate of concession shall be applicable as the base rate of concession for the remaining period of the year 2008-09.


