Office Memorandum

Subject: The effective date for recognizing production Bench Mark of SSP Units for production of SSP under the guidelines No.22011/4/2007-MPR dated 13.8.2009 with effect from 1.10.2009.

The undersigned is directed to say that the revised policy for ad-hoc concession for Single Super Phosphate (SSP) applicable w.e.f. 1.10.2009, inter alia, provides that ad hoc concession for SSP w.e.f 1st October 2009 would be provided to those eligible SSP units only, which have either annual capacity utilization of at least 50% or annual production of 40,000 MT of SSP, which ever is lower. For the purpose of recognizing capacity utilization/ production, capacity as on 31st March 2009 would be taken into account. The capacity utilization/ production of the unit for three months from the date of the notification dated 13.8.2009 on pro-rata basis would be taken into account for reckoning the production benchmark for ad hoc subsidy for sales of SSP w.e.f 1st October 2009. Further, effective date for request from SSP units on case-to-case basis.

2. In the above context, the following mentioned three companies requested to Department of Fertilizers for recognizing production benchmark for the SSP produced by their units respectively as mentioned below:
