**Subject : Monthly Summary of Dept. of Fertilizers for the month of May, 2018**

**1. Revival of Sindri, Gorakhpur and Barauni units :**

Sindri unit alongwith Gorakhpur and Barauni units is being revived by Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Limited (HURL), a Special Purpose Vehicle of nominated Public Sector Undertakings. This project is likely to start production in 2021.

Hon'ble Prime Minister laid the foundation stone for HURL's Sindri project on 25.05.2018.

**5. Promotion of City Compost :**

The sale of city compost by Fertilizer Marketing companies in May, 2018 was about 8940.00 MT and cumulative sales of city compost during 2018-19 (April, 2018 to May, 2018) are about 11958.00 MT. The sale of city compost in bulk, by compost manufactures in May, 2018 was about 8654.00 MT and cumulative sales of city compost in bulk during 2018-19 (April, 2018 to May, 2018) are about 12228.00 MT. The fertilizer companies have adopted 384 (210 in 2016-17 and 174 in 2017-18) villages for promoting the use of city compost in FY 2018-19.

**6. Subsidy Released :**

Out of total budget of Rs. 73439.85(Cr.), Department of Fertilizers has released subsidy to the tune of Rs. 11194.15(Cr.) i.e. 15.24 % of the budget is spent.

**7. DBT :**

- In March, 2018, all states went live on DBT making it a total of 31 DBT live states/UTs.
- Across the country, DBT state coordinators in coordination with the LFS conducted 6457 trainings till April'18 as part of PoS deployment and PAN India roll out of DBT. During the month, 327 additional refresher training programs have been conducted.
- A notification on Interim Procedure/Arrangement for sale of subsidized fertilizers to mixture/customized fertilizer manufacturing Units under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) valid for a period of six months (w.e.f. the date of issue of notification) has been issued on 23.05.2018.
- As per initial requirement, 209483 retailers have been sensitized. On the initial requirement of 209010, 100 % deployment was completed. Against additional requirements from states, another 463 PoS devices have been deployed during the month.
- Weekly meeting through video conference were conducted with all State Agriculture departments to review status and issues at state level.
