OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (Shipping) in the Department of Fertilizers by deputation (including short term contract)/absorption failing which by direct recruitment basis regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that one post of Assistant Director (Shipping), Group A, Gazetted post of General Central Services in the pay scale of Rs. 8000-275-13500/- (Pre-revised) revised to PB-3 Rs. 15600-39100/- + 5400 (Grade pay) is required to be filled up by deputation (including short term contract)/absorption failing which by direct recruitment basis from amongst the following.

1. Officers under the Central/State government/ Union Territories/ Port Trusts/ public sector undertaking:-

- (a) (1) Holding analogous posts on regular basis: or
(ii) With five years regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 6500-10500/- (Pre-revised) Revised to PB-2 Rs. 9300-34800/- + 4800 (Grade Pay) or equivalent, or
(iii) With eight years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 5500-9000/- (Pre-revised) Revised to PB-2 Rs. 9300-34800/- + 4600 (Grade Pay) or equivalent, and
- (b) Possessing educational qualification and experience prescribed for direct recruits which are as under.

Note: - Only officers of Central/State government/Union Territories are eligible for being considered for appointment on transfer basis. (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (Including short-term contract)/Absorption shall be not exceeding 56 years as on closing date of the receipt of application.

Essential:

- (i) Degree of a recognized University or equivalent
(ii) 3 years experience of Shipping/Chartering of Ships/port Operation.

Note 1:- Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2:- The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of Selection the Union Public service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Desirable:

Associate ship/ Fellowship/Diploma in shipping from the Narottam Das Morarji Institute of Shipping, Bombay or any recognized international Shipping Institutes or equivalent.

2. Pay and allowances and other terms and conditions of the selected officer will be regulated as per instructions contained in the Department of Personnel & Training's O.M No. 2/29/91-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 05.01.1994 as amended from time to time.

3. It is requested that particulars in the annexed proforma (in duplicate) of the eligible officers who could be spared in the event of selection may be forwarded to Sh. Rakesh Kumar, Deputy Secretary (A), Room No.-104, Department of Fertilizers, B wing, , Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi through proper channel within 45 days from the date of publication of this office Memorandum in the Employment News along with their complete and up to date CR dossiers.

4. A certification that no vigilance case is either pending or contemplated against the officer along with Certificate of Integrity and Certificate that no Major/Minor penalty was imposed during last 10 years may also be sent to this Department.

5. The applications of officers received without the ACRs or with incomplete information/documents will not be entertained. Candidates, who volunteer to be considered for this post, will not be allowed to withdraw their names later on.
